

CAR PARKING ARRANGEMENTS FOR 2016-2017

The University of Salford has new car parking arrangements in place from 05 September 2016. All visitors to the University will be required to pay for parking (24 hours a day) via '[pay by phone](#)'. This can be done on-line, by telephone or via text. Alternatively, if you are a regular visitor to the university then you can [download the app](#).

A list of the available car parks, their locations and capacities is below and there will be ample signage in all the car parks with instructions as to how to pay for your parking. We recommend that you allow a little extra time when arriving at the university, particularly on the first occasion that you are using the new system.

Please note:

- No cash, cheque or debit card payments will be accepted
- Permits **must** be displayed at all times when using any university car park. Failure to display a permit will result in a penalty notice being issued. Any penalty notice appeal should be directed to Parking Solutions 24.
- Security staff have the discretion to refuse access to car parks likely to be filled up by prepaid permit holders.
- Motorcycles must park in the marked designated areas only. There is no charge for motorcycle parking.
- Parking on double yellow lines is not permitted on any part of any campus. This will be strictly enforced by Parking Solutions 24.
